# 1. DEFINITION

- Like **qui** and **que**, **où** and **dont** are relative pronouns, and as such link a relative clause to the main clause, providing more information.
- In French, **où** and **dont** cannot be omitted in the sentence.
- Both words have several possible translations.



# 1. USES

Pronoun	Functions	
Où	Indicates place and/or time	<i>When, where, which, that...</i>
Dont	Replaces the object of the preposition <b>de</b> , indicates possession	<i>Of which, of whom, from which, that, whose</i>



## 2. USES

- *C'était le moment **où** j'ai réalisé que je l'aimais...*
- *It was the moment where I realised that I loved her/him...*
  
- *Voici le sac à main **dont** je rêve.*
- *Here is the handbag that I dream about.*
  
- *Le restaurant africain **dont** on nous a parlé se trouve sur Long Street.*
- *The African restaurant that we heard about is on Long street.*
